It has been encouraging to see people ready to take on new work within Christ Church, as well as those willing to continue the ministries they have already been involved in. Over the next few weeks I will be following up those offers of new work – but it won't all happen at once, so please don't think that your form has been lost, or that you have been forgotten!

Rather less encouraging was the fact that only around a third of our regular members filled one of the forms in. That is a good indicator of the challenge that we face in becoming the church God has called us to be. If we are to effectively bring the good news to Moreton, each of us will need to play our part. It might be financial, as you give to support the ministry of Christ Church. It might be practical, as you use your gifts in service. It might be in prayer, as you commit yourself to sustained, faithful prayer for the mission of Christ Church to this community.

You will hopefully have seen that the PCC have identified 3 priorities for the next couple of years at Christ Church. One is identifying and training new leaders (and Sam's departure is a reminder of why that is so important.) The second is work with Children, Young People, and Families. The third, and maybe most important priority is Prayer. As Paul wrote to the Ephesians, we need to be praying on all occasions, with all kinds of prayers, for all the saints. (Ephesians 6:18)

Communion Services at Christ Church
