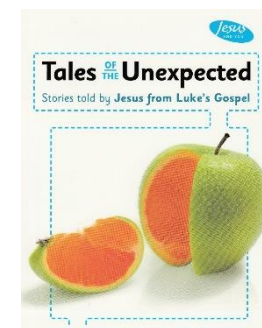


NEXT SUNDAY 10.45 AM
