On *Wednesday 14th November at 7.30 pm* the Bishop of Birkenhead Keith Sinclair will be with us for our Confirmation Service. Confirmation is a great opportunity for anyone who has either come to faith or has recommitted their life to Jesus over the past 18 months to publicly mark their commitment to Jesus and to commit themselves to serve him as part of Christ Church. Even if you have been confirmed in the past, it is possible to renew your Baptismal Vows at the service. In the run up to the service we will be holding a 'Preparing for Confirmation' course, which will run on Monday evenings starting Monday 15th October. If you feel that confirmation might be an appropriate step for you to take, please speak to Graham.
