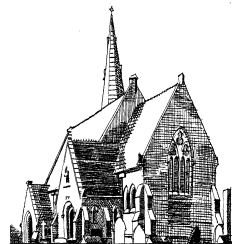

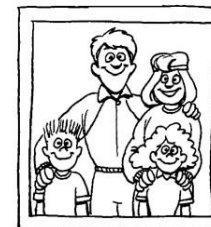
Advent
