

Dear friends at Christchurch

February is, of course, the month for love! Across our society, Valentine's Day, on 14th February, is the day for Red Roses and many other expressions of love. And it is a month when we can put love at the heart of Christ Church.

First — as Lent begins. Lent is often seen as a time to give up something you enjoy (though few people seem to know why we should do such a strange thing!) But it is really a period of preparation for Easter. And in Easter we see the amazing love of God for us — in giving his Son to be our Saviour. If you do give up something for Lent, make sure that it is so that you will be able to appreciate a bit more of the depth of God's love for you.

Second – if we do know of God's love for us, we will want to love him in return. We will want to love the Lord our God with all our heart and mind and soul and strength (Mark 12:30) Our Essential Jesus series is a great way to grow in our love for God, as we understand more of who Jesus is, and what God has done for us through him.

Third – as well as loving God, we need to love others. And for those we know who don't yet know Jesus, the greatest thing we can do for them is to help them discover God's love for themselves. Out theme verse encourages us to do that – *one generation will commend your works to another* (Psalm 145:4). And **'Come to the Light'** is a great opportunity to do just that. The mission starts on 17th February, and the most loving thing you could do for a non-Christian friend is to invite them along.
