CHRIST CHURCH FINANCES:

Our financial figures for September.....

The cost of running the church and Parish Centre in September was **£7,242.53**, the income of the church was **£6,350.52**, leaving the church underfunded by approx **£178.42** per week for the month of September.

So far this year the cost of running the Church and Parish Centre is **£64,401.41**, the income received so far is **£47,564.10**.

This means that if we are to continue our current services and activities our giving needs to increase by £177.29 per week.
