Dear friends at Christchurch

Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make your paths straight. Proverbs 3:5-6

Trusting the Lord needs to be at the heart of discipleship. And trust, of course, has to start with listening – we need to know what the Lord says before we can trust him. So for the next couple of months at our Sunday morning services, we will be hearing what Jesus had to say on various subjects, as we continue our sermon series on Matthew's gospel. When the Israelites were under constant attack from Midian, Gideon was found by God hiding in a winepress effectively paralysed by fear.


But God took him and turned him into a 'mighty warrior'.


Our new series of Café Church continues on Sunday 16th February, as again we ask 'What would Jesus say to'.
