

Dear friends at Christchurch

If you were given an extra hour each day, what would you spend it doing? That's one of the questions which has been used as a starter in our home groups – it can be a bit of fun, but it highlights a serious issue. Because what you would spend that hour doing might well point to what is most important in your life – the thing you would choose rather than anything else.

All of us have things which want to take first place in our lives. It might be family, or work. It might be music or sport or a hobby. All of those things are fine, but none of them can be the best thing to give your life to. None of them deserve your first love. Our theme verse for this year challenges us to *Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding. In all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight.* Proverbs 3:5-6.

In other words, if you want your life to be all that it could be, you need to trust in the Lord. He needs to be first. This month in our morning services we are going to think about what that means in practice – as we see where our passion really ought to lie. And on Sunday evenings we will continue that theme as we think about what we can do to encourage that passion to grow.

Of course, if you are passionate about the Lord, you will want to live in a way that pleases him. In our home-groups we will be looking at the 10 Commandments – God's guidelines for a good life – a life which pleases him.

And if you are passionate about the Lord, you will long for others to share that passion. Next month we will be starting a new Christianity Explored course. Do be praying about who you might bring along.


