So much happening! But unless the Lord Jesus is at the centre of it all, it will achieve nothing. Let's pray that through all of these services and events, he will be honoured, and people will be drawn to him.

Men's breakfast meets Ladies lunch = Curry Night!


*Christ Church Curry Night Saturday 22nd November 2014 @
