Christ Church Building 2015 Appeal

At our AGM in April, we launched our 2015 building appeal. There are several things both inside and around the church building which we need to deal with: The work has now begun: the repairs that were needed on the roof have been done, and the new loop system will shortly be installed. There is also some important work we need to do:

- To replace the carpets in church – which are now very worn.
- The paths around the church are in poor condition, and in some places are an accident risk. We need to carry out repairs on these, so as to make the churchyard safe for church members and for visitors.
- In places the churchyard walls are in poor repair, and need repairing before they collapse.

We set a target for this appeal of £28,000. Thank you to all those who have contributed to the appeal so far – the current total is £15,800 – a great start, but still some way to go. The appeal will be closed at the end of November – just 2 months away. Whether you have already given to the appeal or not, please pray about your response – we really do need to complete this work.

SECURITY
