

It's true! All the good things we have are gifts from God. Living in a world where we can walk into the supermarket and buy whatever food we want from all over the world rather than having to grow it ourselves, it is easy to forget that actually, it is God who gives the harvest. But for all our human ingenuity, the advances in agriculture and transport, we still are dependent on rain and sun, on the miracle that turns a tiny seed into a fruit-bearing plant. We are dependent on God, not just spiritually, but materially as well.

It's true! All the good things we have are gifts from God. And that means that no matter what our circumstances, we have much to thank God for. At our Harvest Services we focus particularly on thanking God for his provision for us, but that thankfulness should characterise all our services. We need to remember God's generosity, to say a heartfelt 'thank you' to the Lord.

It's true! While in this life our enjoyment of God's good gifts can so easily be spoiled by the brokenness of the world, we have a hope that goes beyond this. In 1 Corinthians 15, Paul uses the harvest to point towards the resurrection – just as the seed that is planted has to die before the plant can grow – in the same way the death of our bodies is the start of a glorious new life. It is that hope which we want to share with others, as we seek to Make Disciples.

Therefore, my dear brothers and sisters, stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labour in the Lord is not in vain.


