SAFE FAMILIES FOR CHILDREN

When a crisis strikes a family with children, its effects can be devastating. Many of us would turn to relatives and friends for support, but some families can be really isolated with nobody there to help them. Stabilising families before they reach breaking point is key to reducing the number of children who need to go into care. Safe Families for Children have been privileged to help over 3000 children since it was launched in the UK in 2013.

Safe Families works with churches to provide Family Friends, Host Families and Resource Friends to help while parents get back on their feet. In the Mersey region, we currently have over 450 volunteers from 160 local churches. We have 30 partnering churches so far in Wirral alone. Our volunteers are amazing; every day we hear stories of how simple acts of generosity and kindness have such an impact on struggling families.
