Remembrance Sunday – 100 Years since Armistice 1918

Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men stumble and fall; but those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. Isaiah 40:30-31

This year Remembrance Sunday falls on the 100th anniversary of the end of the First World War. Here at Christ Church, more than 20 men lost their lives during the Great War, and are remembered on the memorial on the north wall of the Church, and on various graves stones around the church yard. To commemorate this anniversary, there will be a display of plaques for each of the fallen at the back of church. I would encourage you to take a moment to take in the display, as we remember those who gave their lives for peace.
