THIRD WEDNESDAY

This year our focus is on the gospel – which is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes. Probably most Christians, when they think of the gospel, think of what we know of it from the New Testament – from epistles like Romans.

But at the start of Romans, Paul says that the gospel was promised by God beforehand through his prophets in the Holy Scriptures (Romans 1:2). Far from being irrelevant, we need the Old Testament if we are to understand the greatness of the gospel. So at Third Wednesday this week we will be exploring The Gospel in the Old Testament.
