

Dear friends at Christchurch

For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes. Romans 1:16

We are now in Lent – for a long time seen as the season of preparation for Easter, a season when Christians pause and make time to do things which will refresh their spiritual lives. And we do need that. At our morning services on the Sunday before Lent we were reminded that the unholy trinity – sin, the world and the devil – constantly oppose us. They try to stop us from embracing the gospel, from taking hold of and enjoying the salvation which it brings. If we are to live life to the full, it starts with drawing near to God. And that is what Lent encourages us to do.

Taking hold of the gospel starts with remembering who Jesus is and what he has done. So through Lent our What's On will have daily readings from Mark's gospel – even if you use other Lent readings I encourage you to join with others in Christ Church as we follow through Jesus life together. Our Lent home groups will also look at the second half of Mark's gospel. And at our 6.30 pm services will work through Luke 22-23 – the last hours of Jesus' life, as we see how that brings life to us.

The salvation which the gospel brings is not some academic thing – it is gloriously life changing. At our morning services we will continue studying the epistle of James, as it shows us how to live out the gospel.

During Lent, many people give up something. Can I challenge you to take up something – to give more time to Bible study, to worship, to prayer. Those are the ways in which we can draw close to God.
