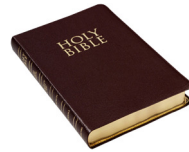
VERSE FOR THE WEEK

Father, help me to be ready to speak of Jesus, even if sometimes it results in me being criticised and rejected.

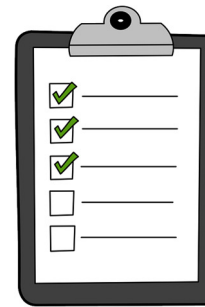
PRAYER PICNIC
