## CHRIST CHURCH ANNUAL PAROCHIAL CHURCH MEETING

Our APCM will be on **Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> October at 12.30 pm**. Because of the current restrictions, we have decided that the meeting will be held using Zoom. I realise that this will prevent some from attending, for which we are sorry, but it seems the only safe way of proceeding.

The meeting will be shorter than usual, as we will just fulfil the legal necessities of the meeting. However, there will still be the chance to make comments / ask questions about matters in the annual report. If you will be unable to attend the meeting, but have something you would like to say or ask, this can be sent to the office beforehand.

As you will know if you have been to the meeting before, we start with the meeting of parishioners, which elects our 2 church wardens. At the APCM itself we will be electing 5 members to the PCC (one is a single year vacancy, the others for 3 years). We will also elect 3 members to deanery synod. Nominations for all these can be made either in writing or by email. Anyone nominated must be proposed and seconded by someone on the Electoral Roll (again this can be done in writing or by email). If you want to check that you are on the Electoral Roll, please contact the office, which hold a list of names but no other details.

If you are able to attend, please let the office know – we will then send you a Zoom invitation to the meeting a couple of days beforehand. We anticipate that the meeting will be over well in time for our 1.30 pm service that afternoon.
