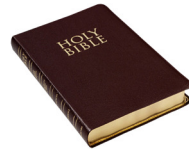
VERSE FOR THE WEEK

Once the final music has finished after the streamed service today, make yourself a coffee and then join with some of the church family for a zoom chat. If you need a zoom invitation please contact Debbi.



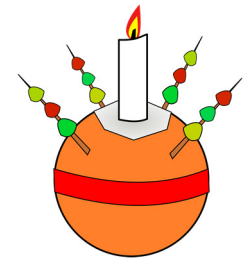
ADVENT BOOK
