READ Philippians 4:2-9.

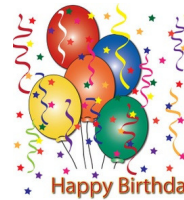
Have you ever been anxious about anything, and found that prayer, either on your own or with someone else, has eased that anxiety?
