ANNUAL PAROCHIAL CHURCH MEETING

Anyone nominated must be proposed and seconded by someone on the Electoral Roll (again this can be done in writing or by email). If you want to check that you are on the Electoral Roll, please contact the office, which hold a list of names but no other details.

If you are able to attend, please let the office know – we will then send you a Zoom invitation to the meeting a couple of days beforehand. We anticipate that the meeting will be over well in time for our 1.30 pm service that afternoon.
