9.00am COMMUNION SERVICE

Next Sunday (23rd May) sees the restart of our 9.00 am service. Although the way we do things will probably develop over the coming months, initially this is what we are planning:

- The service will be communion every week, with the first Sunday of the month being BCP.
- Face masks will need to be worn throughout the service, (except when receiving communion). Social distancing will need to be maintained – please use the numbered seats.
- There will be no singing, and we will not share the peace.
- We will use single use service sheets, which will contain the liturgy and readings.
- There will be a basket on the welcome desk for your collection.
- Communion will be administered using only wafers – please stand at the communion rail if you would like to receive.

To help us plan for the first service, please let the office know if you intend to be there. After that we hope there will be no more need to pre-book.
