MEETING TOGETHER AS CHURCH

Following the Prime Minister's announcement on Monday about the lifting of coronavirus restrictions, on Tuesday the PCC spent some time discussing what this means for our services. Although we are still awaiting further guidance from the government / Church of England, at present our view is: (from Sunday 25th July)

- ◇ Our meetings together should be controlled by 'Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also the interests of others (Philippians 2:4, ESV)
- ◇ We recommend the continued wearing of face-masks, but would not want anyone to stay away because they are uncomfortable wearing one.
- ◇ We will continue with our current distancing arrangements, both for seating and for communion.
- ◇ We await guidance on singing, but pending that we would encourage you, if you want to sing, to do so quietly.
- ◇ We won't start serving refreshments after our services yet, but please feel free to meet up for fellowship in the rear car park when the weather is good.

Hopefully we will be able to relax things further before too long!
