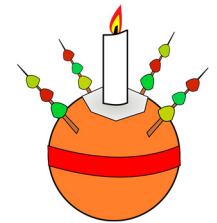
The Church weekend away has been rebooked for the weekend of the 17th to the 19th June 2022. Please keep the weekend free if you want to come and join us.

If you are able to help out at any of these services or are able to help with the making of the Christingles please contact the office.



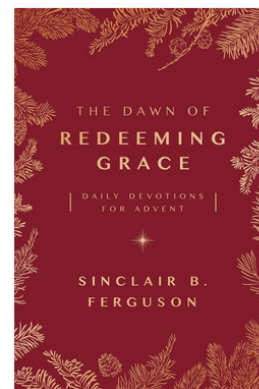
HAPPY BIRTHDAY
