GIFT AID

Gift aid is a good source of income for the church and it doesn't cost anyone (apart from HMRC) anything to do. If you pay tax we can reclaim an additional 25% of your giving from HMRC. If you haven't filled in a gift aid form previously we can also back date any gift aid on donations you have made in the last 4 years with your permission. For those people who do currently gift aid with us we need to ensure we have the correct details for you and therefore we have to ask you to complete new forms every few years, and we need to ask you to do this now. There are forms available in electronic form from the office or Lynda Jones, or printed copies at the back of church. Please could I ask everyone who is able to, to complete a gift aid form and drop it into the church office as soon as possible. Thank you in advance for your support.
