**10.30 am** Walk of witness starting at Moreton Baptist Church ending at Moreton Methodist Church with a service at 11.00 am

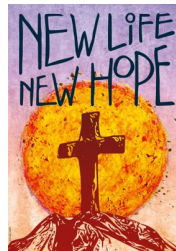
**2.00 pm** An hour at the cross , in Church
