COMMEMORATION SERVICE

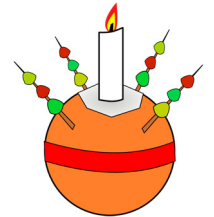
We will be holding our annual Commemoration service today (Sunday 6th November) at 4.00 pm.
